The great thing about not winning a handicap tournament is that not only can you blame your partner (not that any Swifts member would do such a thing!!) but you can also blame the handicapper for getting it wrong.

It is worth making one point that might be a useful tip for some of you after this tournament. Please think about what you are wearing to play badminton in. To play a competitive match in tracksuit bottoms, long shorts or three-quarter length trousers is not very helpful because all of these garments restrict your movement. It would be much better to wear shorts, a skirt or a skort (for the girls) and to allow yourself complete freedom of movement.

In addition you will be very hot and your performance will be hampered if you wear your tracksuit top, fleece, hoodie or sweater while playing. It is important for your health that the heat you generate during your badminton activity can be dissipated by your body and such items restrict its ability to regulate its temperature. Again, trousers are a handicap here.

So leave the fashion statements for afterwards and make sure your clothes are suitable to play badminton in. You will never see Gail Emms and Nathan Robinson playing in trousers or hoodies!
