### Summary

A result somehow missed from last week's newsletter was the fine 7-3 victory of the U10s away to Wimbledon.

After two matches were cancelled, we were left with just two matches this weekend, both on Saturday and both in the Surrey League.

The U14 mixed team played at home to Ebbisham and lost 2-6, though the games were all very close and the match could easily have been a win.

The U16 mixed team played at home to Limpsfield and won by 8-o.



## **Playing in matches**

After Chadacre cancelled our friendly U12 match on Saturday claiming they couldn't field a team sufficiently strong to face us, we attempted to arrange a Swifts X v Swifts Y fixture to replace it. This would have saved the club some money and, at the same time, given match-playing opportunities to four more players in addition to those originally selected.

This attempt was ruined, however, when two of the original team of four refused to play in such a fixture, and the whole thing was called off.

This unacceptable behaviour ruined what would most likely have been a good close match and an opportunity for several other members to play . Perhaps the players concerned were unaware that Swifts X v Y matches, far from being second best, produce some of the closest competitive badminton available as the two teams are matched in ability as far as is possible, with each player playing against a closely-matched opposite number. One of the best ways to develop as a badminton player is to play matches against opponents of a similar standard.

One has to doubt the motivation of players who take this attitude, and I would welcome feedback from those who don't wish to play in such fixtures in the future.

We (by which I mean the committee, coaches and team managers) put enormous effort into the Swifts competitive programme, as well as creating replacement opportunities when matches get cancelled, and it seems a shame that club members can be so disrespectful of their fellow-members as to ruin some of this effort.
