Match summary

On Friday the U18 girls clinched their divisional title by beating Eagles away by 8-2.

On Sunday, in the ACDBL, the U12 boys played away to Streetswater and won by 199-85, slightly aided by Streetswater having to play an over-age boy and not having enough court time to complete the match.

The U12 girls also won away to Streetswater, by 163-149, again aided by Streetswater having to concede rubbers because of a lack of court time.

The U16 girls played away to Bourne and won by 202-126 and cannot now be overtaken by any other team in their division.

The U11s (though two of them were significantly younger) played away to Bourne in a friendly match and won by 208-83.

The U18 mixed team played away to Carshalton in a Surrey League match and suffered its first defeat of the season, 3-5, to a full strength Carshalton team.

National tournaments

Samodani Wijetunge played in the national U11 championships on Sunday, finishing as a semi-finalist in the girls' singles ands as runner-up in the doubles.

County representation

Jamie Ellis, Justine Walker and Kirsty Walker all played for the Surrey (adult) fourth team that defeated Worcestershire 4ths on Sunday in the ICC, completing an undefeated season for the team.

Sarinda Wijetunge played for the |Surrey U17 team in the Shires League against Sussex on Saturday.

Ollie Thompson played for the Surrey U13 in the Shires League twice this weekend—onSaturday against Hampshire and on Sunday against Berkshire.

Harriet Gosztonyi played for Berkshire U13s against Surrey.

Club graded tournament

As you are all aware, it was the first weekend of the club graded tournament on Saturday—the sixth year in succession that we have run the event. The entry broke all records—44 boys and 25 girls actually played—and we played more matches than ever before (186).

The event was divided into three grades for the girls and four for the boys to ensure that everyone was playing against people of a similar standard to themselves, regardless of age.
