### **Match summary**

On Friday the U18 mixed team visited Eagles in the ACDBL and won 166 -133.

On Saturday the U16 girls played at home to Bourne and won 208-144.

The U16 boys' B team also played Bourne at home and lost 112-210, but this was turned into a 148-126 win as one of Bourne's players was a Swifts player (Alex Downes) standing in for someone who didn't turn up to play and his games were all conceded to Swifts for league purposes.

### **Surrey results**

The Surrey U15 doubles and mixed championships were held on Sunday.

In the A grade boys' doubles Nathaniel Brittany and Stirling Burrow were runners-up while William Manners and Nick Pipe both (separately) managed to reach the semi-finals.

In the girls' doubles Stephanie Pipe was runner-up.

In the A grade mixed event Stirling Burrows and Stephanie Pipe reached the semi-finals.

In the B grade Imogen Galvin won the girls' doubles.

### **County representation**

Serena Farrelly and Harry Williams were both members of the Surrey U11 team that defeated Hampshire 14-6 in a friendly county match on Sunday.

On Sunday Ollie Thompson played for the Surrey adult 3rd team against a Berkshire 1st team that included Jack Kinmond who has just ceased to be a Swifts member.

### **National circuit results**

Sam Williams played in the BE U13 Kent Bronze JC on Saturday and won the boys' doubles. Christopher Lai also played in this event and reached the semi-final of the boys' singles.



Ollie McCoy-Page was runner-up in last week's U13 boys' singles tournament but managed to get away before the photos were taken. This week we tracked him down and captured his medal for posterity.

Ninety players made it to the start line for our handicap doubles tournament on Saturday. Three dropped out during the week but none failed to turn up on the day this week. This is a record for a Swifts tournament and the combined entry for both weeks, of 167, is also the best ever.

Once again, we owe thanks to the parents and older members who helped us out by scoring games for the U10s and beginners, helping to keep the players herded during the day and to the various organisers who helped with aspects of the event management, particularly the handicaps and running the event on the day.

Many newcomers managed to get amongst the medals, which should help to boost their confidence and only two players (Stephanie Thomas and Holly Weston) managed to follow up their singles gold medal last week with a doubles gold this week. This meant that the 49 medals were won by 39 different players over the two weeks of the tournament.


