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Match summary

On Saturday the U14 boys team clinched our first Surrey League divisional title of the season by beating Ebbisham at home (who turned up with a girl instead of one of the boys) 10-0.

The U18 mixed team also played Ebbisham at home and beat another team that was missing a player, by $6\frac{1}{2}-1\frac{1}{2}$.

The U14 mixed B team played at home to Yateley Hawks in the ACDBL and won 168-96.

The U10 unisex B team played away to Horsell and lost 97-189.

On Sunday a very young U12 boys' A team played away to Bourne and suffered its first defeat of the season, in a very close encounter, by 172-180. The resulting league point was enough to clinch our twelfth division of the season, with two matches still to play.

In the Surrey League the U10 unisex team played away to Chadacre and lost a very tight contest by 4-6.

Callum Mitchell and Harry Williams both played in the Surrey U13 A team that defeated Hertfordshire in the Shires League on Sunday.

This is an unusual doubles tournament in that players don't get to choose their own partner. We aim to allocate partners such that all the pairs within a grade are as evenly-matched as possible. We even put in a lot of effort to try and do this for individual games where we have an odd number of players in a grade and one player has several partners. Our success in doing this is variable but can often be judged by (a) the number of close games, (b) the number of tied places we have to resolve and (c) the number of grades where all the pairs win at least one game or don't win all their games.

Despite the number of times well tell people otherwise we are always being asked *Is it decided on points?* and the answer is always the same (and always has been) - a firm *No!* But the award for the silliest question of the day went to the boy in grade D who asked *How many points are we playing to?* This might sound a reasonable question to ask until you realise he didn't ask it until he had been playing for well over an hour and he had already had finished three games! Doh!







Though we would like to, we cannot offer mixed doubles for everyone, partly because there isn't enough time and partly because only 43% of members are girls (though, as many other clubs only have 10% girls, we are lucky). However, we do try to have a mixed event for the best players entered each year (again, usually limited by the number of girls available). Interestingly, the last-placed pair decided who won the silver medal by beating Alice & Darren by just one point. Had the result gone the other way, Alice & Daren would have been runners-up by virtue of their marginally better record against Steven & Polly. That is close!
